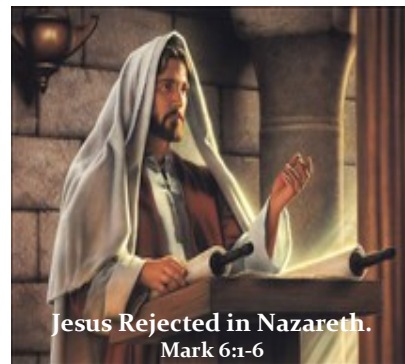
Eucharist is celebrated every Sunday at 7:30 am and 9:00 am

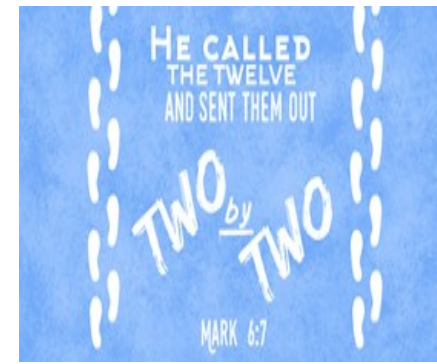
