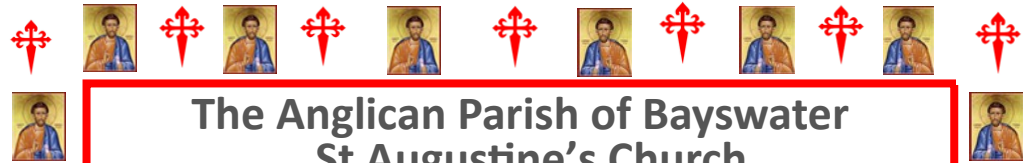

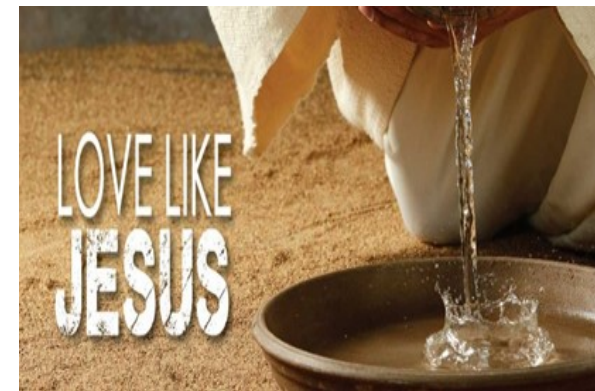

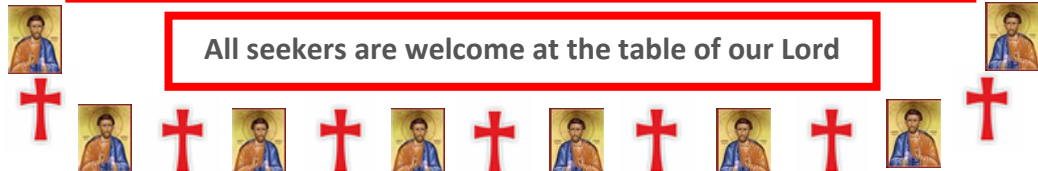
### The Holy Communion
