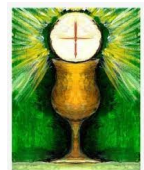

An invitation is extended to morning tea following the 9:00 services



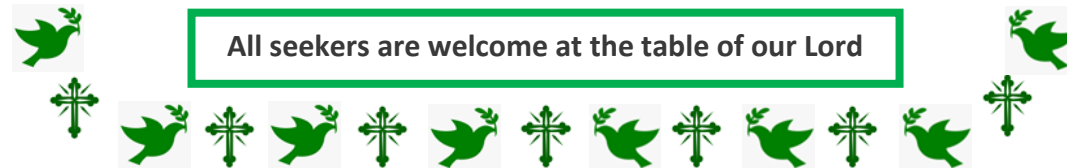
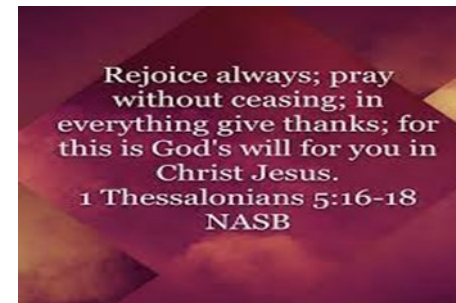
Sentence of the day (read by the Priest)

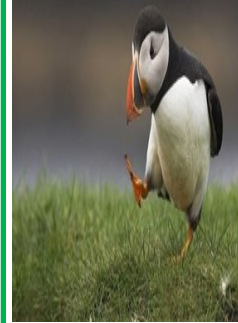
