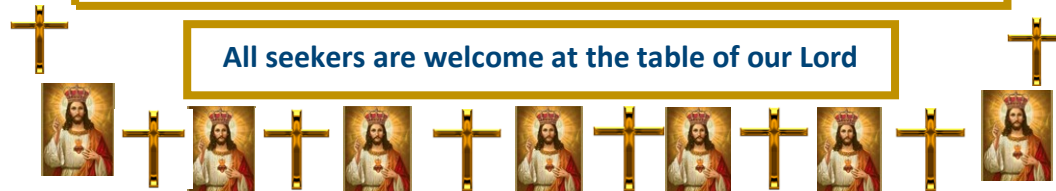
The Holy Communion

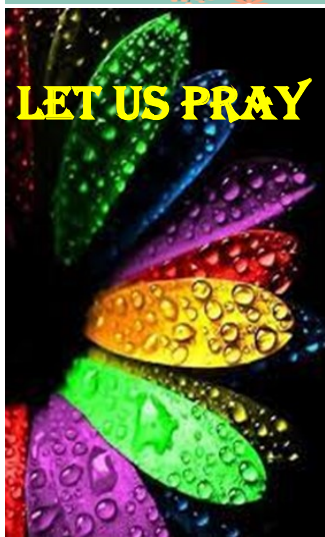
